One of Josh Billings' maxims is "Rise early and work hard and late, give nothing away, and if you don't die rich and go to the devil you may sue me for damages."


Said a seven-footer to a diminutive specimen of humanity, who approached him threateningly, "If you were to strike me, and I should accidentally find it out, you would be sorry."


