



Michigan State College Agricultural Experiment Station is studying ways of making leaf feeding practical to the average grower. Among plants which respond readily to nutrition through their leaves are tomato, celery and corn, aswell as apple trees. Best results have been obtained by spraying relatively low concentrations of plant food during the spring and early summer. As more information is obtained, it will be available to you by calling, writing or visiting your County Agricultural Agent.
